

# REPUBLIC SERVICES COLLECTION PROTOCOL

# for BRIDGELAND RESIDENTS

- TRASH COLLECTION with 96 gal Republic Services Trash Cart Twice per Week
- RECYCLING COLLECTION with 96 gal Republic Services Recycling Cart Weekly on Wednesday
- HEAVY TRASH and YARD WASTE COLLECTION Weekly on Wednesday
- Have all collections at the curb by 7 a.m.
- Place carts 5 feet from any object to insure a safe collection. Close cart lids.
- Republic Services closes for these holidays: Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Years Day.

# TRASH AND HEAVY TRASH COLLECTIONS - The following items and materials Will NOT be collected

- Dead animals
- Arsenic
- Chemical containers over 5 (five) gallons
- Nuclear/radioactive waste
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Gasoline
- Insecticides
- Pool chemicals/filters
- Sheetrock or drywall
- Solvent
- Power steering fluid
- Anti-Freeze/coolant
- Herbicides/pesticides
- Storm debris
- Construction/home remodeling debris
- Ammunition or Explosives

- Mercury
- Thermometers
- Motor Oil
- Paint/paint cans
- Varnish/stain
- Batteries
- Transmission fluid
- Used oil filters
- Poison
- Medical waste
- Liquids
- Propane tanks
- Wood or fencing
- Nails
- Tires
- Windows/doors
- Insulation
- Stone or concrete

- Tree trunks
- Water softeners
- Basketball goals not broken down
- BBQ grills or smokers over 35 pounds

## **HEAVY TRASH and YARD WASTE COLLECTION – Weekly on Wednesday**

Up to 2 bulky items and up to 6 bags or bundles of yard waste per collection day

### **Acceptable Heavy Trash Items**

Household Appliances – Refrigerators must have Freon drained and be tagged accordingly by a <u>certified</u> technician.

Hot water heaters must be drained.

Live Christmas trees. Ornaments, tinsel, and lights to be removed.

Furniture. Mattresses.

Grills must be emptied of ash or briquettes. No propane tanks.

### **Packing Peanuts**

Packing peanuts won't be collected loose - must be bagged. Drivers will not clean up packing peanut spills.

#### **Yard Waste**

Bush and tree trimmings cut in lengths not to exceed 4 feet, no greater than 2 inches in diameter, securely tied in bundles, not to exceed 35 lbs. All grass clippings, and leaves must be bagged.

## **Acceptable Recycling Items**

- Paperboard
- Brown Paper Bags
- Phone Books
- Catalogs
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Junk Mail

- Tin and Steel Cans
- Aluminum Cans
- Office and School Paper
- Cardboard
- Plastics 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7
- Cereal and Food Boxes
- Remove food/liquids and rinse recyclables before putting them into the recycling cart.
- ✓ Do not put recyclables in a plastic bag before putting them into the recycling cart.
- ✓ Do not put in the recycling cart anything that is not listed above...no plastic bags, clothing, rubber hoses, etc.
- ✓ Do not put yard waste in your recycling cart.
